The Wayne County Family Enrichment Program is a free early education program for families with children prenatal to age three living in Wayne County and is funded by the Illinois State Board of Education through the Wayne County Health Department. Learning activities take place at the Early Childhood Services building 420 Market Avenue, Fairfield, IL. The program offers the following activities:

- Monthly Parent/Child Groups
- Family Fun Activities
- Personal Home Visits bi-weekly
- Referrals to other Community Resources
- Child Health, Development and Social Emotional Screenings

The goal of the Family Enrichment Program is to provide the learning foundations that will assure success in school and in life. Studies have shown that parents can increase their young child's learning power by loving, playing, reading, singing, and talking. The program offers the research-based curriculum "Parents as Teachers" and also provides referrals to other early intervention services.
