Evangelism

Matt. 28:19 Christ commanded: "Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, and teaching them to **obey** everything **I have commanded** you. And surely, I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

In Times of Ignorance

- **Acts 17:30** In the past God overlooked such ignorance, but now **he commands all** people everywhere to **repent.**
- **1 Peter 1:14** As **obedient** children, do not conform to the evil desires you had when you lived in **ignorance**.
- **1 Tim. 1:13** Even though I was once a blasphemer and a persecutor and a violent man, I was shown mercy because I acted in **ignorance** and unbelief.
- Eph. 4:18 They are darkened in their understanding and separated from the life of God because of the ignorance that is in them due to the hardening of their hearts.

Expose Them

- **Isa. 58:1** To the **law** and to the **testimony** they speak not according to this word, it is because there is **no light** (*no truth*) in them.
- Lev 5:17 "If a person sins, and commits any of these things which are forbidden to be done by the commandments, though he does not know it, yet he is guilty and shall bear his iniquity."
- Hos 4:6 "My people are destroyed for <u>lack of knowledge</u>: because thou have rejected knowledge, I will also reject you, that you shall be **no priest to me**: seeing you have **forgotten the law** of your God; I will also **forget your children**."
- Isa. 58:1 Cry aloud, spare not; lift up your voice like a trumpet; tell My people their transgression, and the house of Jacob their sins.
- Eph. 5:6 Let no one deceive you with empty words, (false doctrine)

 (Man' opinion's; Words not from sound doctrine of the Scripture Isa. 8:20)

 for because of such things God's wrath comes on those who are disobedient.

 7) Therefore, do not be partners with them.
 - 8) For you were once darkness, but now you are light in God. Live as children of light
 - ⁹⁾ for the fruit of the light consists in all goodness, righteousness and truth
 - 10) and find out what pleases God.
 - Have nothing to do with the fruitless deeds of darkness, but rather expose them.

- Rev. 22:18 If anyone adds to these things, (*Gods laws*) God will add to him the plagues that are written in this book; ¹⁹⁾ and if anyone takes away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part from the Book of Life, (*Eternal Life*) from the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book.
- **2 Tim. 2:24** God's servant must not be quarrelsome but must be kind to everyone, able to teach, not resentful. ²⁵⁾ Opponents must be gently instructed, in the hope that God will grant them repentance leading them to a knowledge of the truth.

Wise Words:

We have many lessons to learn, and many, many to unlearn. God in Heaven alone is infallible. Those who think that they will never have to give up a cherished view, never have occasion to change an opinion, will be disappointed. CET 203

When a brother receives **new light** upon the Scriptures, he should frankly explain his position, and every minister should **search the Scriptures** with the spirit of candor, and see if the points presented can be substantiated by the Inspired Word. GW 303

Ministers and Pastors are to **prove** their brother or sister wrong from the Scriptures.

Our brethren should be willing to investigate in a candid way every point of controversy. If a brother is teaching error, those who are in responsible positions ought to know it; and if he is teaching truth, they ought to take their stand at his side. We should all know what is being taught among us; for if it is truth, we need it.

We are all under obligation to God to know what He sends us. He has given directions by which we may test every doctrine. [Isa 8:20 quoted.] If the light presented meets this test, we are not to refuse to accept it because it does not agree with our ideas. ... When a doctrine is presented that does not meet our minds, we should go to the word of God, [and] seek God in prayer. (*6)

We must not for a moment think that there is no more light, no more truth to be given us. We are in danger of becoming careless, by our indifference losing the sanctifying power of truth, and composing ourselves with the thought, "I am rich and increased with goods, and have need of nothing." [Revelation 3:17.] While we must hold fast to the truths which we have already received, we must not look with suspicion upon any new light that God may send. (*7)

Obedience to His Commandments

There can be no government on earth or in heaven without laws.

- **Rom. 7:12** The **law is holy**, and the commandment holy and just and good.
- **Prov. 28:9** One who turns away his ear from hearing the law, Even his prayer is an **abomination**.
- 1 John 4:8 God is love. (Law of Love = God's Government)
- Matt. 22:36 "Teacher, which is the great commandment in the law?"
 - ³⁷ Christ said to him, "You shall love YeHoVaH your Elohim with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.
 - ³⁸ This is the **first** and great commandment.
 - ³⁹ And the **second** is like it: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.'
 - ⁴⁰ On these two commandments hang all the Laws and the **Prophets**."

Heavens Recording Angels handwritten records of our sins are the **only regulations**, *ordinances*, record, charges, which are *against us for disobeying the Laws of Moses*.

Sacrificial laws were nailed to the cross but not His moral laws because God and His laws are the same.

The commands of the God is pure,

9 The judgments of the God are true and righteous.

- 1Thess. 5:5 You are all **children of the light** and children of the day. We do not belong to the night or to the darkness. ⁶ So then, let us not be like others, who are asleep, but let us be awake and sober.
- "Everyone who does evil hates the light, and will not come into the light for fear that their deeds will be exposed.
 But whoever lives by the truth comes into the light, so that it may be seen plainly that what they have done has been done in the sight of God."
- 1Pet. 2:9 But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light.
- **Prov. 4:18** The path of the righteous is like the morning sun, shining ever brighter till the **full light of day**. ¹⁹ But the way of the **wicked** is like **deep darkness**; they do not know what makes them stumble.

Wise Words:

That God who **reads the hearts** of everyone, will bring to light hidden things of darkness where they are often least suspected, that **stumbling blocks** which have **hindered the progress of truth** may **be removed**, and God have **a clean and holy people** to **declare His statutes** and **judgments**. (*8)

Obedience will secure you peace of conscience, the favour of YeHoVaH, and at last Christ's glorious benediction, 'Blessed are they that do His commandments that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city.' Rev. 22:14.

If you value these things more than the fleeting friendship of this world, the objection we speak of will not amount to much; otherwise, it will.

Usage Notes

Our Heavenly Father told us in **Isaiah 8:20** that we are not to believe man's words, but **believe only Scriptures**. Our Saviour also told us;

Mar 12:38 Christ stated: "Beware of the Scribes," (Translators of Scriptures)
