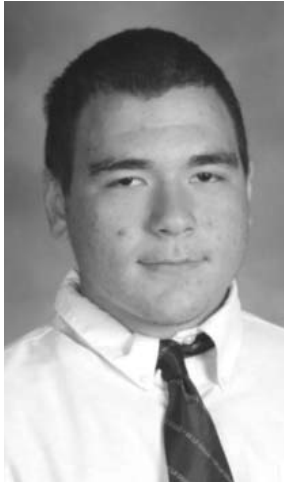

Students who received the immunization last year or anytime since 2005, simply need to show proof.
