What is yielding to the Holy Spirit?

Galatians 2:20 *"I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me."*

The youngest believer knows to yield to the perfect Spirit of Christ.

Matt 5:44 *"But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you."*

Let's start here for tonight's prayer. **Forgiveness**. It was Forgiveness that brought Jesus Christ to earth to die for each of us. So we will begin this evening petitioning Jesus for strength to forgive.
