

For NMGA regular scoring events - in case of inclement weather, causing less than desirable conditions – one of the executive will review playing conditions prior to the event and if it is decided that lift, clean and place should be implemented, a sign will be displayed on the first tee box.

Lift, Clean & Place Procedure

When the course is deemed to be played under the “LIFT, CLEAN & PLACE” rule by the executive committee. The procedure will be as follows.

On the **fairway you are playing**, mark the position of your ball, lift your ball clean it and replace it as near as possible to its original spot, not closer to the hole. If your ball is plugged it may be replaced away from the pitch mark, not closer to the hole.

This rule does not apply to bunkers, penalty areas, or rough.
