EUC Program Ends Dec. 29

A federal unemployment insurance program beyond the initial 25week regular state program will expire at the end of 2012, according to the Illinois Department of

Link

Employment Security.

The federal program is referred to as Émergency Unemployment Compensation. When federal lawmakers passed the last extension of the program, they included a Dec. 29th hard-stop ending date. Regular state benefits will remain in effect.

Illinois businesses pay into the Unemployment Insurance Trust Fund to provide for the regular unemployment program, which lasts for 25 weeks for individuals who first claimed the benefit in

Earlier this year, the Extended Benefit Program expired after specific thresholds were met, including a falling unemployment rate. EB provided benefits for up to 20 weeks of unemployment insurance.

EUC was divided into Tiers I, II, III and IV. Collectively, they provided up to 53 weeks of unemployment insurance.
