The Chicago Park District's outdoor ice skating rinks are open through Sunday, Feb. 23 at most outdoor rinks,

weather permitting. A new rink has been added at Wentworth Park, 5625 S. Mobile Ave. The ice rink at Daley Bicentennial Plaza is closed due to Maggie Daley Park construction. There are no longer ice rinks at West Lawn Park or at Wrigley Field.

Most ice rinks will feature programming including pick-up hockey games.

Open Skate is offered 7 days a week. Skate rentals for all ages: \$6. Admission is \$3 for adults and free for children and students with ID. Adult admission with skate rental: \$7. Friday evening family skate, 6:30 – 9 p.m., special price: \$10 (includes skate rental)

Weekly Drop-In Learn to Skate Sessions are to Skate Sessions are offered on Saturdays, from 11:45 a.m. to 12:30 p.m., prior to open skate at all outdoor rinks except Midway Plaisance Admission: \$10; includes skate rental (based on availability) and entry to availability) and entry to public skate.

This drop-in session provides instruction on the basics of balance, forward stride, starting and stopping, and backward skating. It is open to all ages and to both hockey players and ice skaters. Recreational or hockey helmets, gloves and knee pads are recommended.

Stick & Puck and Pond Hockey offers 45 minutes of Stick & Puck followed by 45 minutes of Pond Hockey for one price. Admission (includes skate rental): is \$7 person, \$10 for adult & child. Recreational or hockey helmet recom-

mended. Stick & Puck offers open access to the ice specifically for practicing stickhandling, skating and shooting skills. No scrimmage games or slap shots are allowed. Youth skaters may be on the ice

with supervision. Pond Hockey is more like the neighborhood pick-up game and is less competitive than rat hockey. No slap shots or body checking are allowed and hockey helmets are required. This program is open to children and adults. Rat hockey is available for adult players to play pick-up games. Full hockey equipment is required, and slap shots are allowed. No checking is permitted.

### **Propose Ban** Of 3D Guns

The City of Chicago would ban the use of sophisticated computerdriven machines that can be used to create stealthlike firearms under an ordinance introduced by 14th Ward Aldermen Edward M. Burke and 11th Ward Alderman James A. Balcer.

The measure would make it illegal for the public to use a device called a three-dimensional printer to manufacture firearms. Possession of 3-D printed guns, which can be made at home out of melted plastic, would also be banned because the weapons have the potential of eluding airport security checkpoints. The only metal parts are the bullets and a firing

pin. The Department of Security Homeland Security recently issued a bulletin warning that "significant advances in three dimensional printing capabilities...may present safety risks.'



# Selective Enrollment Policy At Schools

### By Dr. Roy Pletsch

How many of your former neighbors have moved to other cities to utilize the better schools? Well, surprise, surprise. According to the State of Illinois and reported in the Chicago Sun-Times, if you judge schools by test scores, eight of the top ten elementary schools in the state are Chicago Public Schools. Seven of the top eight middle schools and four of the top five high schools are Chicago Public Schools. On these three top lists, only Rockford and Springfield have two schools and none are from the ones that are always thrown at us: Plainfield, Naperville, Tinley Park and Orland Park.

The hard part is get-ting into these schools, but yes, even if your stu-dent officially has a dis-hillity theorem shifts ability, they are eligible for any of the ten selective enrollment high schools, six Military Academy Schools, and, if you wish, schools, and, if you wish, there is the highly re-garded Inter-national Baccalaureate program in many schools including Kelly, Juarez, Curie and Back of the Yorda Back of the Yards.

The final date for application is Dec. 13th and they are available in any Chicago Public elementary school. The process for students is the same for graduates of parochial schools.

But as I have always told my students, don't wait until the last minute to prepare, because it is the seventh grade final grade on report card in reading, math, science and social studies, along with the seventh grade standardized test. Students then are eligible to take the entrance exam.

There is a model for points that a parents will become aware of by reading the packet. I always told my students that there are many fine programs in neighborhood high schools but go there because it is your choice, not because you have to go there. Three of the Military Academies - The Marine Math and Science Academy, Air Force Academy and Chicago Military Academy at Bronzeville and three of the top five high schools - Jones, Whitney Young and Walter Payton are in in close proximity. If your student waits until seventh grade to take school seriously, they probably will not attend one of these great schools. Remember there are many fine Catholic high schools that are

available. They also have an entrance exam, which I will write about in an upcoming issue.




