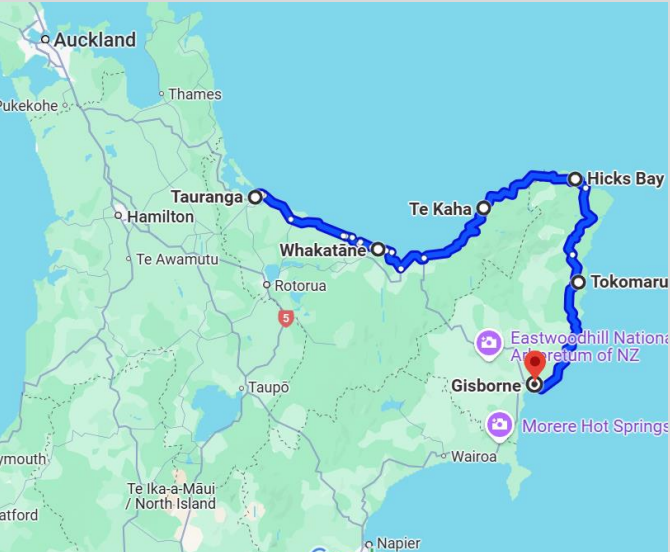

Driving Times & Distances

- Gisborne to Tokomaru 1½ hour drive/ 95kms
- Tokomaru to Hicks Bay, 1½ hour drive / 92 kms
- Hicks Bay to Te Kaha, 1¼ hour drive/ 82 kms
- Te Kaha to Tauranga, 2¾ hour drive/199 kms

Getting To Gisborne

- With up to seven direct flights a day from Auckland to Gisborne it’s an easy place to get to.
- Alternatively, Gisborne is a 3 hour drive from Napier and 3 ½ hour drive from Rotorua .

All driving times are approximate and do not allow time for stops. We recommend you allow extra time to enjoy your journey with safety
