On the second floor, a master suite is a large spacious room that includes a king size bed and



a sitting area. It is wonderful area to escape and enjoy the scenery from the upstairs windows. Futon can also accommodate extra sleeping if needed.



The library in the Master Suite and the sitting area in the basement offer a varied assortment of books for your pleasure reading.



The sitting area in the basement is located in a little nook on the other side of the large room. The library offers again an assortment of mystery, fiction, health, and children books. We simply ask that you enjoy the books and be sure to leave them behind when you depart Pine Village.

Bear Lodge has three full baths that include showers, toilet and custom made cabinetry; look for the bear and deer cabinets.



A 4th bathroom is a modern outhouse located to the left of Bear Lodge. Complete with a flush toilet and outside sink. Sink is perfect for filleting those fish. Open from May 1 to October 30.

Bear Lodge has a deck that wraps around the entire lodge. To the right of the entry is cooler to store drinks and comfortable seating to enjoy visiting, eating, or watching for wildlife.

There are plenty of seats for all to sit and enjoy the view of Little Pine Creek. It is a great place to watch the birds, including a blue heron and an occasional eagle that might fly by or the hummingbirds that visit the feeder.
