Brian is from a large Irish American family with a distinguished tradition of service in the political, legal, law enforcement, fire service, educational, building trades and cultural life of the Irish American Community.

Brian enjoyed a long and accomplished career in the NYPD Detective Bureau and was widely recognized for his service in the Irish Peace Process during which he served as the American liaison and facilitator for key Irish participants in the process, while also providing logistical support and security. He is currently a System Director with the WMC/Bon Secours Charity Health System and is a consultant in investigative and security operations, creative and educational projects.
