This Week's Program



Dr. Robin Battershell presented our program today. She talked about the Temple Independent School Districts 2015 proposed bond issue. The bond issue for \$136.5 million dol-

lars and the projected maximum monthly tax increase is \$9.57 per month for a \$100,000 home. The money will be going for Temple High School and Wheatley renovations for \$60,800,000. Renovations to Bonham, Travis and Lamar middle schools will cost \$28,500,000. And elementary renovations and new construction takes care of the remainder of \$47,200,000.

Dr. Battershell talked at length about the accomplishments for the Temple Independent school system. The new state rating grants stars for the top 25% and Temple middle schools received eight stars for excellence and Temple high school received six out of a possible seven!

Early voting is from October 19 to the 30th and election day is November 3. Dr. Battershell urged us to get out and vote.
