Lunch on own on the way. Arrive at **Motts Military Museum** - Motts Military Museum offers an extensive collection of artifacts spanning from the Revolutionary War to modern conflicts, including uniforms, weapons, military vehicles, and aircraft. Special exhibits highlight significant themes such as the Tuskegee Airmen, the space program, and a 9/11 artifact display, providing visitors with a comprehensive insight into America's military history. Depart for Wilmont . Check into Amish Door; dinner included. After dinner, enjoy **USO Show at the Amish Country Theater** -The Dave Banks Big Band offers a captivating USO-style variety show. This performance features a patriotic salute alongside renditions of iconic songs delivered by talented performers. Back to hotel....sweet dreams!

Thursday, July 16, 2026....Breakfast at hotel. Depart for **Age of Steam Roundhouse** - features a fully operational 18-stall brick roundhouse housing an extensive collection of historic steam and diesel locomotives, passenger cars, and railroad equipment. Next stop is **Newcomerstown Main Street USA for lunch, Vane Scott Salute to Old Glory Show**, visit Main Street USA Museums.
