The NCAA Division III football national championship game is called the Stagg Bowl, named after Amos Alonzo Stagg. Stagg was inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame as both a player and a coach in the charter class of 1951 and was the only individual honored in both roles until 1990.

Stagg also developed basketball as a five-player sport so that his football team could play each other and stay in shape over the winter. Stagg was elected to the Basketball HOF in its first group of inductees in 1959.
