**Program: Julie Fitzgerald- Living with Parkinson's**



This week we had the pleasure of hearing from Julie Fitzgerald who discussed living with Parkinson's. Julie was diagnosed with Young Onset Parkinson's disease. She has transformed her personal journey into a powerful platform for education, advocacy, and empowerment. After undergoing Deep Brain Stimulation (DBS) surgery in 2013, she emerged with a renewed mission: to reshape how Parkinson's is understood and to support others facing disease. Julie spoke about common causes of Parkinson's such as genetics, age, gender, environmental toxins and head injuries. Parkinson's looks different for everyone, but there are common signs such as tremors, stiffness, and bradykinesia (slowness of movement).

## Fun Facts & Did you Knows?

Parkinson's disease is named after James Parkinson, an English surgeon and geologist who first described the condition in 1817. Later, in the 1860s, French neurologist Jean-Martin Charcot recognized the importance of Parkinson's work and proposed that the disease be named after him. This suggestion was widely adopted, and the condition became known as Parkinson's disease.
