Motion to Quash, Discovery Motion

No appearances. These matters having been under submission the Court now rules as follows:

1. The Motion to Quash is granted only as to those parties the District Attorney represents.
2. The Court finds that Defense Counsel did not act unethically in the preparation of the Subpoena Duces Tecum, although the language "Response to be sent to Law Office of C. Thomas McDonald, 600 West Santa Ana Blvd., Penthouse Suite, Santa Ana, CA 92701" could be misleading and violative of the law. However the Court finds that this was the result of inadvertance by counsel and not an intentional effort to mislead the recipient or violate the law.
3. On the submitted items in the Discovery Motion the Court rules as follows:
 - a. 22 and 23, refused.
 - b. III A,B, and C -- The court misspoke in saying, "refused as already covered." These requests are refused because they are vague, overbroad and incapable of compliance.
 - c. Item D in the Amendment to Discovery Motion is granted as
