INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLICANTS

ELIGIBILITY RULES

Any graduating High School Senior Student, College Student, or Trade or Technical Student, providing his or her amateur standing is maintained, is eligible to complete an application for this scholarship. Students may receive this scholarship **ONLY** two (2) times. Students must meet the following requirements:

- a) USBC Youth bowlers must enter their junior or senior year of high school and maintain good standings at their High School.

These students must have bowled a minimum of 2 full seasons as a USBC Youth bowlers.

All information must be complete and returned to Helen Leon by **August 1, 2026**.

- b) Maintain membership under the Tallahassee USBC Association.
- c) Is a participating member of a youth/collegiate bowling league certified by Tallahassee USBC and is in good standing for the current season.

- d) **Include a current copy of the bowlers' Official school transcript(s) with the application.**
