DAY 1...All Aboard! Enjoy a day of travel. Overnight lodging and dinner included. D

DAY 2...Depart for Virginia Beach. Check into oceanside hotel and enjoy the beautiful sunset. Dinner included. B, D

DAY 3...Depart to **Ft. Story Army Base** to see the historic first landing site and Cape Henry Lighthouses. **MUST HAVE A PHOTO ID** to get into the base. The Joint Expeditionary Base is comprised of the former Naval Amphibious Base Little Creek and the Army Post of Fort Story. Fort Story witnessed the humble beginnings of our country at the 1607 first landing site. Little Creek began as a dynamic training ground for World War II amphibious forces. Together they comprise the crown jewel of America's military bases! Next will be the **Cape Henry Lighthouse**. Depart to Cape Charles via the Chesapeake Bay Bridge Tunnel, **ONE OF THE WORLD'S** greatest engineering marvels with over 17 miles of bridges and tunnels connecting VA Beach to the Eastern Shores of Virginia. Time for lunch on your own and a walk on the beach for great photos. Return to the Inn for some free time. This evening we will visit the **Aviation Museum in Virginia Beach...America's Flying Museum with SWING TIME in the SKIES!** Group visit will include a tour of the hanger, private air show with antique plane, full BBQ dinner with USO show singers!!! This purpose-built airport facility includes over 50 aircraft from the World War I and World War II-era. The museum is also home to historical structures located on 130 acres. B, D

DAY 4...**Depart for Nauticus Museum with USS Wisconsin Battleship.** Enjoy time to explore the Nauticus Museum showcasing our Naval History. The showpiece of the museum features the USS Wisconsin Battleship docked next door. Walk right out onto the deck to experience the majestic war ship! Enjoy cruise on **Victory Rover Naval Boat**. Cruising the smooth waters of the Elizabeth River, tour one of the world's busiest seaports including the world's largest naval base, home of the Atlantic Fleet, made up of destroyers, guided missile cruisers, submarines, aircraft carriers and more. Following two-hour cruise we will continue our military adventure by visiting the **McArthur Memorial** to pay our respects to one of America's most decorated generals. Following included dinner, depart to the SCOPE ARENA for **International Tattoo Music Festival**.....considered as one of the most impressive live musical shows in the world featuring military bands, singers, and dancers from around the GLOBE!! Virginia International Tattoo is America's premier showcase of military music and pageantry, presented annually by the Virginia Arts Festival in Norfolk. The production brings together massed pipes and drums, military bands, precision drill teams, dancers, and choirs from around the world. Expect immersive staging inside Scope Arena, from spotlighted soloists to thunderous ensemble moments that honor service and celebrate global friendship. Each program blends time-honored tradition with fresh storytelling, so returning fans and first-timers discover new highlights every year. B, L, D

DAY 5... Depart to the Outer Banks. Stop at **Morris Farm Market**. As one of the largest farm markets in Northeast North Carolina, they have a reputation of being a favorite experience by locals and tourists. After lunch on your own, depart for **Wright Brothers National Monument**. The Visitor Center is home to a museum featuring models and actual tools and machines used by the Wright brothers during their flight experiments including a reproduction of the wind tunnel used to test wing shapes and a portion of the engine used in the first flight. This is where Wilbur and Orville Wright made the first powered airplane flight. Travel to Kitty Hawk for our oceanside lodging. Dinner included this evening. B, D

DAY 6...First on our agenda, enjoy a stop at the Currituck Beach. Built in 1874 this is the lighthouse in its original structure. Construction on the **Currituck Beach Lighthouse** first began in 1872, and the structure was completed and first lit on December 1, 1875. It is still in use TODAY. Depart to Timbuck II Shopping and Dining Center for free time and lunch on your own. Next stop is the **Wild Horse Tour**. Guests will see the Corolla Wild Horses, descendants of the Spanish Mustangs brought to the New World by explorers as long ago as the early 1500s. View the horses in the open-air Safari-style vehicle. Dinner is included this evening. B, D

Day 7...Depart to **Bodie Island Lighthouse**. The lighthouse is part of the **Cape Hatteras National Seashore**. Lunch is included today. Next stop is the **Cape Hatteras Lighthouse**. The most famous lighthouse in North Carolina, and one of the most well-known lighthouses in America, Cape Hatteras Lighthouse is the tallest brick lighthouse in the United States. Depart to Village of Manteo for **Johnny's Dolphin Cruise**. You will hear a factual narration on the Bottlenose Dolphin. Breathtaking views are all around you on this tour. Dinner included. B, L, D

DAY 8...Depart for Mt. Airy. Take a step back to simpler times in Mount Airy, the home of Andy Griffith and the town that inspired Mayberry in The Andy Griffith Show. Enjoy a **Squad Car Tour** going by many of the landmarks from the show. Dinner included. B, D
