### **This Weeks Program: Michael Donahue**



This week we had the pleasure of hearing from Michael Donahue. Mr. Donahue is a nationally recognized artist, educator, author and historian with over four decades of experience in the visual arts. He currently serves as a Piper Professor of Art at Temple College, where he has taught since 1979, offering courses in Drawing, Design, Painting, and Art Appreciation. Mr. Donahue has also served as a National Park Ranger at Little Bighorn Battlefield National Monument in Montana for more than 30 years. He is also the author of several acclaimed books, including Drawing Battle Lines: The Map Testimony of Custer's Last Fight, Where the River Ran Red: The Indian Fights of George Custer and How to Kill Custer in 35 Minutes. Mr. Donahue continues to inspire students, historians, and artists alike through his passion for art, education and American History.
