The pat-down will be conducted by a TSA officer of the same gender and you may ask that the TSA officer change their gloves before performing a pat down. The agent will ask whether you have an injury or tender area so to treat such areas accordingly during a pat-down. You may request to have a pat-down in private and be accompanied by a companion of your choice. You will not be asked to remove any clothing. Isn't this good information?

It wasn't until 713 BC, that January and February was added to synchronize the lunar year and the calendar year with roughly 354 days. Back then both months had only 28 days. For the next 200 years, February was the last month of the year, not December.
