### ➤ THIS WEEKS PROGRAM

Dr. Robin Battershell gave us an update on the state of TISD. She reported that the work from the 2007 bond election has been completed. Science labs, ag barn, auditorium remodel and technology infrastructure. All the work from the 2011 bond election, new Jefferson elementary school, new parking lots at four other elementary schools, renovation at Meridith-Dunbar, Travis Science Academy, Bonham and Lamar MS's, new windows at Cater and Thornton and upgrades at THS and Scott have all been completed. Also, work from the 2013 TRE have all been complete. This is all part of the 10 year plan and she said that there is possibly going to be a 2015 bond election to continue the plan. In addition she said that because of interest rates being low and construction bids being better than expected, the tax increase was less than expected.

Next she talked about Temple's career and technical education program. Temple ISD has partnered with Baylor Scott and White, Temple Machine Shop and coming in 2015-2016 PDI. Temple is in the top 6 districts in the state and top 60 in the nation and according to Dr. Battershell, they are doing it better than any other district she has seen. Students are graduation with not only college credits, but real life experience and are getting hired right out of high school for good paying jobs. 80% of the students at THS are involved in this program.

Finally, Dr. Battershell talked about the districts IB program. Temple is one of only two 5A Single High School Districts with a true IB program, from elementary to High School. The thread begins with Scott elementary, runs thru Travis middle school and then THS. The elementary school IB program is one of a very few in the country.

Overall the state of the district seems to be very strong and the Wildcats were in the State Finals this year in football (in case you hadn't heard).
