Enclosed is an application accepted by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) dated July 22, 2024, from Halliburton Energy Services, for a specific license (XB1368) to export sealed sources of Cesium-137 for oil, gas, and well logging in Libya.
