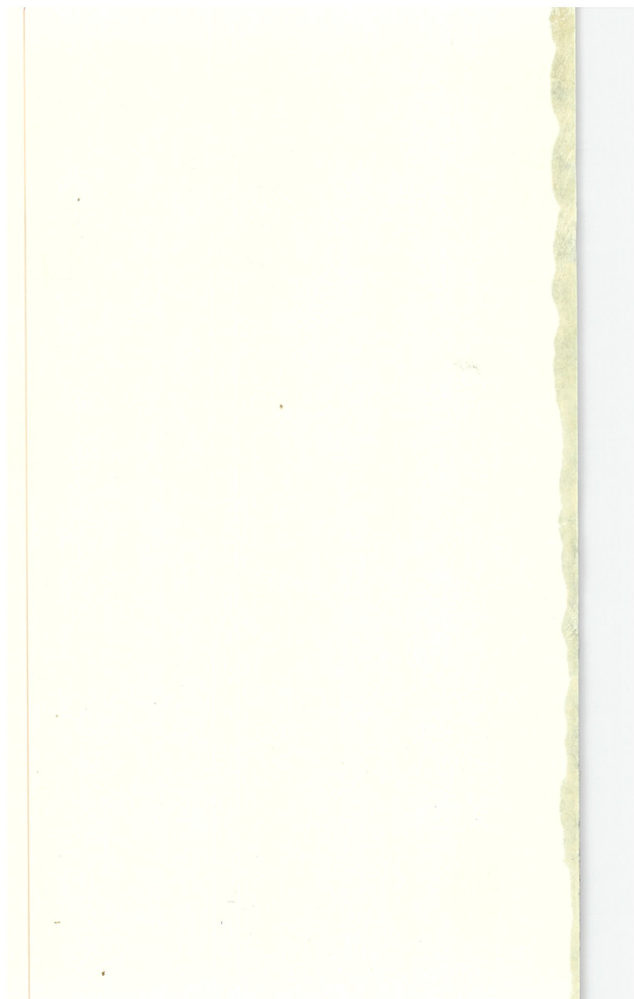

about himself





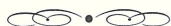
He works hard

restaurant





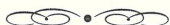
He likes

taking charge



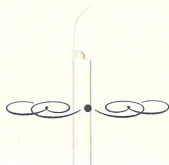
