MICHAEL W----,

CALLED AS A WITNESS BY THE DEFENDANT, HAVING
BEEN FIRST DULY SWORN, WAS EXAMINED AND TESTIFIED AS FOLLOWS:

THE CLERK: STATE YOUR FULL NAME FOR THE COURT AND
SPELL IT, PLEASE.

THE WITNESS: MICHAEL W----, W----.

THE CLERK: THANK YOU. YOU MAY BE SEATED IN THE
WITNESS STAND, MR. W----.

DIRECT EXAMINATION

BY MR. MC DONALD:

Q. MR. W----, YOU TESTIFIED EARLIER, YOU
UNDERSTAND THESE PROCEEDINGS ARE DIFFERENT. THESE
PROCEEDINGS ARE TO PROVIDE WHAT INFORMATION YOU HAVE ON
RANDY AS A HUMAN BEING SO THAT THE JURY CAN UNDERSTAND
HIM. YOU UNDERSTAND THAT?

A. UH-HUH, YES, SIR.

Q. WHEN DID YOU FIRST MEET RANDY?

A. UHM, LATE 60'S, EARLY 70'S.

Q. AND WHERE DID YOU MEET HIM, IF YOU RECALL?

A. LAGUNA BEACH AREA.

Q. CAN YOU DESCRIBE FOR THE JURY THE KIND OF THE
SOCIAL SETTINGS OR SOCIAL STRUCTURE OF GAY PEOPLE IN THE
60'S, PARTICULARLY THE LATE 60'S; I MEAN, WHERE WOULD--

WHERE DID THEY GO TO CONGREGATE? WHERE DID THEY MEET?

WHAT TYPE OF ENTERTAINMENT, GENERALLY SPEAKING?

A. WELL, GENERALLY, AT THAT TIME, BECAUSE OF THE HARASSMENT, OR WHATEVER YOU WANT TO SAY, THAT TYPE THING, IT WAS BASICALLY BAR ENVIRONMENT. TALKING ABOUT THE BARS, IT ALWAYS SOUNDS LIKE WE ARE OUT DRINKING CONSTANTLY, BUT IN THE, THE LATE 60'S IT WAS-- THERE WAS A BAR IN LONG BEACH; LAGUNA BEACH WAS POPULAR, THE BEACH AREA, AND TWO BARS THAT WERE THERE AT THAT TIME.

Q. SO THIS-- SO IT WASN'T NECESSARILY THE DRINKING THAT WOULD ATTRACT YOU OR OTHER GAYS TO THE BAR SETTING, IT WAS THE FACT THAT YOU COULD BE THERE WITH OTHER PEOPLE, OTHER GAY INDIVIDUALS?

A. THAT WAS THE ONLY ENVIRONMENT THAT WAS OPEN TO BE WITH YOUR PEER GROUP AT THAT TIME.

Q. OKAY. SO YOU HAVE KNOWN RANDY LATE 60'S UNTIL HE WAS ARRESTED?

A. THAT'S CORRECT.

Q. CAN YOU TELL THE JURY THE TYPE OF CONTACTS YOU HAVE HAD WITH RANDY OVER THE YEARS, TYPE OF SOCIAL SETTINGS, OCCASIONS YOU HAVE BEEN TOGETHER? NOT ALL OF THEM, BUT SOME OF THEM, SO THEY KNOW A LITTLE BIT ABOUT THOSE.

A. WELL, AT FIRST WE REALLY NEVER GOT THAT SOCIAL UNTIL ABOUT 1975 WHEN I MOVED BACK TO LONG BEACH. IT WAS MOSTLY-- ONE TIME HE WAS BARTENDER AT ONE OF THE

POPULAR BEACH BARS DOWN IN SUNSET BEACH. WE WOULD STOP IN AND BASICALLY WAS A MEETING ON ASOCIAL LEVEL AT THE BAR, "HOW ARE YOU DOING?" EVERYBODY IS HAVING A BEER, TALKING AROUND AND THAT KIND OF ELEMENT.

WHEN I MOVED BACK TO LONG BEACH IN 1975, HE LIVED A FEW BLOCKS FROM ME. I DIDN'T KNOW A LOT OF PEOPLE IN LONG BEACH AND I KNEW RANDY. AT THAT TIME, YOU KNOW, WE WOULD BE GOING FOR DINNER AND STOPPING OVER, GOING OUT AND HAVING A DRINK TOGETHER, GO TO MOVIES.

Q. WERE YOU GOING ALONE ARE WERE YOU GOING AS A COUPLE?

A. NOT AS A COUPLE. IT WAS, YOU KNOW, FRIENDS. THERE WAS NOTHING BETWEEN RANDY AND I.

Q. OKAY.

A. AT THAT TIME.

Q. HOW ABOUT LATER, THOUGH? DID YOU AND RANDY AND A GROUP, GROUP OF COUPLES GO TO TAHOE, FOR INSTANCE?

A. YEAH, ABOUT '75. I MET MY PARTNER NOW AT THAT TIME, AND IT WAS, I DON'T KNOW WHEN HE MET JEFF, BUT NOT LONG AFTER THAT IS WHEN WE BECAME MORE SOCIAL ON, YOU KNOW, MIXING, GROUP-TYPE THINGS. THAT'S ABOUT THE TIME THE POKER GROUP STARTED AND THAT WAS OPEN TO 10, 15, 20 PEOPLE GOT TOGETHER EVERY OTHER WEEK ON THAT.

AND THEN I THINK, LET'S SEE '79 OR '80 IS WHEN WE WENT TO TAHOE. HE WAS WITH JEFF AT THAT TIME AND TWO OTHER FRIENDS OF OURS.

Q. OKAY.

A. AND THE--

Q. NOW, YOU SAY YOUR PARTNER. YOUR PARTNER WAS
PHIL?

A. PHIL C----.

Q. OKAY. DID YOU EVER THROW PARTIES IN WHICH
YOU INVITED RANDY AND JEFF AND OTHER FRIENDS OF YOURS?

A. OH, YEAH, LOTS OF TIMES.

Q. WHAT TYPE OF PARTIES AND HOW MANY WOULD COME
OVER AND WHAT ACTIVITIES WOULD TAKE PLACE?

A. AT THAT TIME WE WERE LIVING IN BELMONT
SHORES, SO IT WAS A BEACH COMMUNITY. THE HOUSE WAS ALWAYS
OPEN. THE HOUSE WAS OPEN, PEOPLE IN-AND-OUT, GOING TO THE
BEACH TYPE THING. WE HAD, GOSH, THIS WAS GOING ON ALL THE
TIME, EITHER BE EIGHT TO 10 PEOPLE OVER FOR DINNER ON THE
WEEKENDS OR SO FORTH. WE DID-- WE ALWAYS HAD A PARTY.

I, I AM RUSSIAN ORTHODOX SO ON THE HOLIDAYS
IN JANUARY WE ALWAYS HAD, YOU KNOW, FAMILY AND FAMILY
PEOPLE FROM THE CHURCH, AND ALL OUR NEIGHBORS IN FOR
RUSSIAN EASTER AND OPEN HOUSE, AND RUSSIAN CHRISTMAS AND
RUSSIAN EASTER ON THAT.

Q. RANDY AND JEFF WERE ALWAYS INVITED?

A. ALWAYS PART OF IT, YEAH, YEAH, ALL
PART OF IT.

Q. YOU HAD LOTS OF OPPORTUNITIES TO SEE RANDY
SOCIAL AND-- WELL, PRIMARILY SOCIAL. DID YOU EVER SEE

RANDY VIOLENT AT ALL?

A. NO.

Q. DID YOU EVER SEE HIM AGGRESSIVE WITH ANYBODY?

A. NO.

Q. DID YOU EVER SEE HIM DISRESPECTFUL TO ANYONE?

A. NO.

Q. EVER EVEN HEAR HIM MAKE AN OFF-COLOR JOKE?

A. WELL, WE ALL TELL THOSE ONCE IN A WHILE.

UHM, NOT-- AS A MEAN, HATEFUL DEROGATORY TYPE THIN, NO.

I MEAN, YOU KNOW, WE ARE ALL GUILTY OF THAT.

Q. WHAT WORDS WOULD YOU USE TO DESCRIBE RANDY IF YOU WERE TRYING TO EXPLAIN TO THE JURY WHO HE WAS FROM YOUR PERCEPTION AND YOUR FEELING DURING THOSE YEARS FROM LATE 60'S TO '83?

A. RANDY WAS A VERY PLEAS- -- THE RANDY THAT I KNEW AT THAT TIME I'M TALKING ABOUT, APPEARED EXTREMELY PLEASANT, PEACEFUL MAN. I DON'T EVER RECALL HIM BEING DRUNK, OUT OF CONTROL, AGGRESSIVE, ANY OF THAT, NONE OF THAT. THE RANDY KRAFT I KNOW AT THAT PERIOD OF TIME IS A VERY PLEASANT, GOOD MAN.

Q. WHAT, WHAT DID YOU THINK WHEN YOU READ IN THE PAPERS HE WAS ARRESTED FOR THOSE CHARGES? WHAT WAS YOUR REACTION?

A. JUST TOTALLY INCONCEIVABLE. I MEAN, IT WAS NOT THE PERSON I KNOW. I, I COULDN'T PUT IT ALTOGETHER AS THE SAME PERSON.

Q. AND IN FACT, SINCE HIS ARREST, YOU HAVE TRIED TO TRACE BACK IN YOUR MIND TO SEE IF THERE WAS SOMETHING, SOME ACT OF VIOLENCE, SOME ACT OF AGGRESSIVE BEHAVIOR, SOME DRUNKEN OR DRUG CONDITION WHERE YOU COULD THING BACK, "AHA, THAT WAS IT." YOU'VE TRIED TO DO THAT MENTALLY, HAVEN'T YOU?

A. YES, YES.

Q. HAVE COME UP WITH ANYTHING?

A. NOT AT ALL, NOT AT ALL.

Q. MICHAEL, RANDY MIGHT HAVE A QUESTION FOR YOU.

BY THE DEFENDANT:

Q. HELLO, MICHAEL.

A. HI.

Q. MIKE, YOU WERE A MEMBER OF THE POKER GROUP, AND WE WOULD HAVE CARD GAMES AT DIFFERENT PEOPLE HOMES AND THAT SORT OF THING?

A. UH-HUH.

Q. YOU HAVE SEEN ME PLAY CARDS?

A. YES, NOT ALWAYS GOOD.

Q. WOULD YOU SAY THAT I AM A COMPETITIVE CARD PLAYER?

A. WELL, THOSE POKER GROUPS, I DON'T THINK THEY WERE ALL THAT COMPETITIVE. I MEAN, IT WAS MORE OR LESS GETTING TOGETHER, WHO CAN OUTDO EACH OTHER WITH CERTAIN--

Q. MORE SORT OF GOSSIP CARDS OR--

A. I THINK PEOPLE TALKED MORE DURING THE CARD GAME THAN THEY PAID ATTENTION TO THE CARDS, YEAH. IT, IT WAS AGGRAVATING.

Q. ALL RIGHT. YOU HAVE BEEN TO MY HOUSE?

A. YES, I HAVE.

Q. AND DIFFERENT LOCATIONS WHERE I HAVE LIVED IN?

A. AND TO YOUR HOME ON OCEAN. YOUR HOME ON ROSWELL WAS THE NEW HOME.

Q. YES.

A. AND UP AT SIGNAL HILL. THERE WAS A PERIOD YOU WERE DOWN IN, WHERE IS THAT, MISSION VIEJO?

Q. RIGHT.

A. UH-HUH.

Q. BUT YOU HAD AN OPPORTUNITY TO, TO, TO BE INSIDE THE PLACES I LIVED?

A. UH-HUH.

Q. EVER SEE ANY SORT OF PARAPHERNALIA LAYING AROUND, WEAPONS OR--

A. NO.

Q. ANY MILITARY GEAR OR BANNERS OR POSTERS OR ANYTHING?

A. NO.

Q. DO YOU KNOW WHAT I WOULD MEAN IF I WOULD SAY "S AND M"? DO YOU KNOW WHAT THAT MEANS?

A. I AM FAMILIAR WITH THE TERM. I WOULDN'T

APPLY THAT TO YOU.

Q. SADOMASOCHISTIC; YOU NEVER SAY ANYTHING LIKE THIS IN MY HOME?

A. NO.

Q. EXCUSE ME. SOME OF THE PARTIES THAT YOU HAD WOULD GET QUITE LARGE, WOULDN'T THEY?

A. VERY.

Q. WHAT WOULD YOU SAY WOULD BE ONE OF THE LARGER, YOU KNOW, PARTIES THAT YOU--

A. 150 PEOPLE.

Q. 150 PEOPLE. THAT IS AT ONE SWOOP THROUGH YOUR HOUSE?

A. (WITNESS NODS.)

Q. HOW WOULD YOU DESCRIBE THE MIX OF PEOPLE AT YOUR, THAT WOULD COME TO YOUR PARTIES?

A. IT WAS SOMEONE FROM EVERY WALK OF LIFE FROM THE PRIEST FROM CHURCH, THE LITTLE LADIES, MY FAMILY TO YOUR FAMILY, TO, YOU KNOW--

Q. GOOD CROSS SECTION OF PEOPLE?

A. YEAH, EVERYBODY.

Q. YOU ARE FAMILIAR WITH RIPPLE'S BAR?

A. YES.

Q. BEFORE THAT IT WAS CALLED-- BEFORE IT WAS CALLED RIPPLE'S, DO YOU RECALL WHAT IT WAS CALLED?

A. A COUPLE NAMES, AND THEN SLITHERY HOUSE ONE TIME, AND THEN OCEANA FOR A HUNDRED YEARS.

Q. SO YOU KNEW IT, WHAT, IN THE LATE 60'S AS
BEING A BAR?

A. YES.

Q. BEING A GAY BAR?

A. (WITNESS NODS.)

Q. ARE YOU FAMILIAR WITH THE PARKING LOT ACROSS
THE STREET?

A. UH-HUH.

Q. IS THAT KNOWN AS A MEETING AREA FOR GAY
PEOPLE?

A. WELL, THAT WAS CONSIDERED THE-- YOU KNOW,
WAS THE PARKING LOT FOR RIPPLE'S, NUMBER ONE, SO EVERYBODY
WAS USING THAT TO PARK IN, GO TO THE BAR; PLUS THE BEACH
WAS-- THE BEACH WAS A GAY ORIENTED BEACH DURING THE DAY.

Q. WOULD-- WOULD IT BE KNOWN THAT EVEN AFTER
THE BAR CLOSED AT NIGHT AFTER MIDNIGHT OR THROUGH THE
MORNING, THERE WOULD STILL BE PEOPLE WANDERING IN AND OUT,
WANDERING AROUND OR DRIVING AROUND IN THAT AREA?

A. THAT'S CORRECT.

Q. DO YOU HAPPEN TO RECALL WHEN I MET JEFF
S----?

A. NO.

Q. YOU DON'T. OKAY.

A. IT HAD TO BE AROUND '75, '76, BECAUSE YOU
WERE INTO THE HOUSE ON LAVERNE.

Q. DO YOU RECALL LIVING IN AN APARTMENT ON

GLENDORA STREET?

A. YEAH, WE WERE THERE FOR-- MIKE O----
LIVED THERE, AND I MOVED IN WITH HIM FOR AWHILE RIGHT
AROUND, JUST WE MOVED INTO THE, THE-- I WAS IN THERE FOR
A FEW MONTHS AND THEN MOVED INTO, IN '76 WE MOVED INTO
LAVERNE PLACE.

Q. DO YOU RECALL HAVING A BIRTHDAY PARTY OR A
LACK OF HAVING ONE FOR YOU, FOR YOUR BIRTHDAY IN 1976 IN
GLENDORA APARTMENT?

A. HAS TO BE '76 BECAUSE WE HAD A PARTY THERE
BECAUSE WE MOVED JUST AFTER MY BIRTHDAY.

THE DEFENDANT: THAT'S ALL.

MR. MC DONALD: CAN I ASK ONE MORE QUESTION, THEN
LET MR. BROWN?

MR. BROWN: SURE.

DIRECT EXAMINATION

BY MR. MC DONALD:

Q. MICHAEL, WHEN I SPOKE WITH YOU THIS
AFTERNOON, YOU TOLD ME ABOUT THIS INCIDENT WHERE YOU HAD
HAD TOO MUCH TO DRINK AND RANDY WAS INVOLVED.

A. UH-HUH.

Q. WILL YOU SHARE THAT WITH THE JURY, PLEASE.

A. WELL, I HAD BEEN OUT TO, AFTER WORK, WITH MY
BOSS AND HIS WIFE, A LONG EVENING OF DINNER AND DRINKING.
AND I DID DRINK A LITTLE TOO MUCH, AND DECIDED-- I
EVIDENTLY HAD IT IN MY MIND I WAS GOING TO GO DOWN TO

RIPPLE'S AND DRINK SOME MORE.

GOT TO THE PARKING LOT AND GOT THE CAR PARKER AND WAS TRYING TO MAKE IT TO THE BAR AND WASN'T DOING TOO WELL. AND RANDY WAS COMING OUT OF THE BAR AT THAT TIME AND DISCOVERED MY CONDITION AND TOOK ME HOME, PUT ME TO BED, AND CAME OVER THE NEXT MORNING TO GET ME TO GO GET MY CAR BECAUSE HE KNEW I WASN'T ABLE TO DRIVE THAT NIGHT. SO--

Q. WHEN DID THIS OCCUR, APPROXIMATELY?

A. IT WAS IN '75, SUMMER OF '75, BECAUSE I WAS LIVING OVER ON THIRD STREET AT THAT TIME.

MR. MC DONALD: THANKS A LOT.

CROSS EXAMINATION

BY MR. BROWN:

Q. WHAT AREAS DO YOU REMEMBER MR. KRAFT LIVING IN, STARTING FROM THE EARLIEST THAT YOU CAN REMEMBER? LET'S STARY BACK--

A. THE EARLIEST?

Q. -- LATE 60'S.

A. WHEN I MET HIM IT WAS, I THINK IT WAS SUNSET BEACH, SOMEWHERE IN THAT AREA. I AM NOT SURE. SUNSET, SEAL BEACH AREA.

Q. OKAY.

A. I STOPPED BY HIS APARTMENT ONLY ONCE ON THAT OCCASION.

Q. THAT IS-- WAS THAT PLACE THAT WAS ON THE

WATER ON THE BEACH THERE ITSELF?

A. I-- IT WAS NEAR THE BEACH, WALKING DISTANCE TO THE BEACH. IT WAS SOUTH OF PACIFIC COAST HIGHWAY, I KNOW THAT, BUT I DON'T KNOW IF IT WAS ON THE BEACH OR TO ME IT'S ON THE BEACH, SUNSET BEACH IS--

Q. DID MR. KRAFT WORK AT THIS BUOY SHED?

A. ON THE WEEKENDS, YEAH.

Q. AND IT WAS ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF PACIFIC COAST HIGHWAY?

A. THAT'S CORRECT.

Q. WAS THIS PLACE THAT MR. KRAFT LIVED AT THAT TIME CLOSE TO THAT BUOY SHED?

A. IT WAS IN THAT VICINITY. I, I CAN'T GIVE YOU AN APPROXIMATE-- YES, IT WAS WITHIN, I WOULD SAY, WITHIN A LONG WALK, A SHORT DRIVE, YES, UH-HUH.

Q. OKAY. SO YOU COULD GO FROM THE BUOY SHED AND WALK ACROSS SOME SAND AND GET OVER TOWARDS HIS HOUSE; WOULD THAT BE FAIR TO SAY?

A. I REALLY CAN'T ANSWER THAT QUESTION.

Q. WERE THERE RAILROAD TRACKS IN THAT AREA AT THAT TIME DOWN WHERE I AM TALKING ABOUT, AS FAR AS THE RAILROAD TRACKS?

A. I KNOW WHERE YOU ARE TALKING ABOUT. I THINK

IT'S A PARKING AREA NOW.

Q. LET'S GO-- THERE IS PACIFIC COAST HIGHWAY?

A. YEAH.

Q. GENERALLY RUNS--

A. YEAH, NORTH AND SOUTH.

Q. SOUTH.

A. THEN A--

Q. THE NEXT--

A. I AM NOT TOO FAMILIAR WITH THAT AREA.

Q. NEXT STREET OVER TOWARD THE OCEAN IS NORTH PACIFIC, AND THEN THERE WERE THE TRACKS, AND THEN THE NEXT STREET WAS SOUTH PACIFIC WHICH WAS THE LAST STREET?

A. THE GRASS AREA NOW OR SOMETHING.

Q. YES.

A. YEAH, YEAH.

Q. CAN YOU RECALL HAVING TO GO ACROSS THAT AREA TO GET TO MR. KRAFT'S HOUSE AT THAT TIME?

A. HUH-UH. THE ONLY TIME I WENT TO HIS HOUSE IS WE HAD DRIVEN UP FROM LAGUNA AND JUST STOPPED OVER THERE AND WENT TO THE BAR. THAT'S AS MUCH AS I KNOW ABOUT HIS LIVING PLACE THERE.

Q. WHAT YEAR WAS THAT, APPROXIMATELY?

A. THAT'S WHEN I FIRST MET HIM. THAT WOULD BE ABOUT '68, '69.

Q. OKAY. AND THEN WHERE DID YOU NEXT BECOME AWARE THAT MR. KRAFT LIVED?

A. IT WASN'T UNTIL-- BECAUSE I MOVED AWAY FROM THE AREA, AND WHEN HE MOVED TO LONG BEACH, THAT'S THE NEXT PLACE I REMEMBER GOING TO HIS HOME.

Q. WHEN DID YOU MOVE BACK TO LONG BEACH?

A. IN 1975.

Q. WOULD YOU SAY YOU WERE A VERY CLOSE FRIEND OF MR. KRAFT?

A. AFTER '75 WE WERE EXTREMELY CLOSE, YES.

Q. SO YOU HAVE NEVER SEEN HIM ANGRY OR ANXIOUS?

A. NO.

Q. HE HAS ALWAYS BEEN VERY CONTROLLED?

A. THAT'S CORRECT.

Q. HE HAS ALWAYS BEEN ABLE TO CONTROL HIS EMOTIONS OR CONTROL ANY FEELINGS HE HAS SO THAT HE DIDN'T HAVE ANY OUTBURSTS; WOULD THAT BE FAIR TO SAY?

A. I NEVER SAW ANY OUTBURSTS, NO. VERY EVEN KEEL PERSON TO ME.

Q. ALL RIGHT. WOULD IT BE FAIR TO SAY THAT THERE WAS NOTHING THAT YOU SAW ABOUT MR. KRAFT THAT WOULD INDICATE THAT HE HAD ANY MENTAL PROBLEM WHATSOEVER?

A. NO.

Q. I AM NOT SURE WHAT "NO" MEANS. DID YOU NOT SEE ANY?

A. I MEAN-- YOU MEAN WHETHER I THINK HE IS CRAZY OR WHAT?

Q. YEAH.

A. NO.

Q. NOTHING WHATSOEVER?

A. NO, NO.

Q. THERE WAS NOTHING?

A. THERE WAS NOTHING.

Q. THANKS FOR COMING IN. WE APPRECIATE IT.

MR. MC DONALD: THATNKS A LOT.

THE DEFENDANT: I HAVE ONE MORE.

EXAMINATION

BY THE DEFENDANT:

Q. MICHAEL, WOULD I EVER DISCUSS PROBLEMS THAT I
WAS HAVING WITH YOU, DO YOU RECALL?

A. NO, NOT THAT I RECALL.

Q. DO YOU RECALL ME COMING OVER WHEN JEFF WAS
SEEING A PERSON THAT LIVED DOWN THE STREET FROM ME NAMED
JOHN? DO YOU REMEMBER THAT SCENARIO?

MR. BROWN: CAN I JUST INTERRUPT ONCE? JUST VAGUE
AND AMBIGUOUS, WHETHER WE ARE TALKING JEFF G---- OR JEFF
S----.

THE DEFENDANT: JEFF S----.

THE WITNESS: I DON'T RECALL THE SITUATION.

THE DEFENDANT: YOU DON'T RECALL THE SITUATION.

OKAY.

THE WITNESS: BUT IT INVOLVED PHILLIP AT THAT TIME,
TOO.

THE DEFENDANT: THAT IS FINE.

THE COURT: THAT'S IT FOR TODAY, GENTLEMAN?

MR. MC DONALD: YES, YOUR HONOR.

THE COURT: LADIES AND GENTLEMEN, YOU MAY BE--
IT'S YOUR DUTY NOT TO CONVERSE AMONG YOURSELVES OR ANYONE
ELSE THE NATURE OR SUBJECT OF THIS TRIAL OR FORM OR
